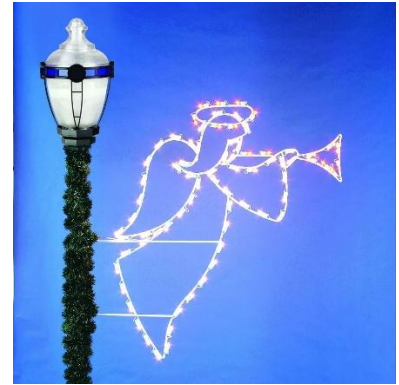
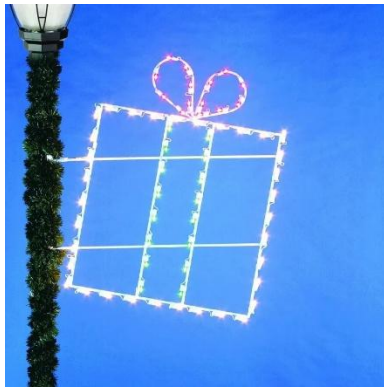
New, unwrapped toys can be dropped off at 3 locations for your convenience:
